EXPLANATIONS:

Award of this contract will enable ESC-Region 19 and its Purchasing Cooperative members to purchase and have delivery to each of its facilities on a regular route schedule for milk, dairy and related food nutritional requirements. The evaluation committee has recommended Price's Creameries who was low bid overall on pricing by \$23,705.60 based on quantities provided by ESC Region 19 members participating in this contract. Both proposals from Dean Foods and GH Dairies agreed to hold firm pricing through July 31, 2015. Additionally, the vendor has agreed to extend this pricing to any ESC Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative members in the El Paso and locally surrounding area. Pricing for year 2 and year 3 will be negotiated with the recommended vendor for award and those price increases or decreases will be tied to the National Milk Pricing Index. Both vendors received high references for services provided to clients in the El Paso area. Item 17 Soy Cheese and Item 18 Rice Milk are low volume and were not considered in the cost calculations. These items may be purchased on an as needed basis. Other items not identified will be invoiced by Price's at 0% discount and GH Dairies agreed to a 12% markup over its cost. Award basis was 70% pricing and 30% vendor abilities to service and reference checks.

GENERAL CONDITIONS –PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. All purchase orders and invoicing will be directly with each district using this contract.
2. **All pricing will start August 1, 2014 and continue through July 2015 with the option to extend in 12 month increments depending on mutual consent by both the vendor and Region 19 Purchasing Coop Member. Maximum contract period for this contract will be 36 months. ESC Region 19 will consider for award fixed one (1) year pricing, fixed pricing in 3 and 4 month increments tied to the Milk Commodity Pricing Index. Additionally qualified proposals other than as specified will also be considered. In those instances, one bid with documentation and copies of the response pages should be labeled bid #1 (conditions included), bid #2 (conditions included), and bid #3 (conditions included) etc. will be considered.**
3. Evaluation and award recommendation will be based on 70% pricing, and 30% of vendor's ability to provide services as specified including reference checks.
4. Award basis will be "all or none" per district with the option to award each district individually or an "all or none" award for all districts, whatever is determined to be in the best interest of the Purchasing cooperative members.
5. Any unacceptable product will be picked up the next business day after original delivery and replaced with acceptable product.
6. Any omitted product from a delivery will be delivered the next business day.
7. All product delivered will be sealed and free from leaks, and be kept at a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit and be delivered in clean sanitary cases.
8. Individual monthly statements will be sent for each campus the vendor has delivered to at the close of each month during the contract period.
9. Vendor will leave **two clear legible invoices** at each campus location upon each delivery showing the location, unit descriptions, and unit price as well as an invoice total.
10. Deliveries will take place between 6:00 AM and 10:30 AM to the cafeterias.
11. Deliveries will take place four days per week during the contract period.
12. Monthly menus for each campus will be provided to delivery personnel upon request.
13. Delivery vendor personnel will check with each cafeteria manager in person one day per week agreed upon mutually so that orders for the following week can be given to the vendor.
14. Escalation in pricing during the contract period will be considered on an individual basis tied to certain commodity fluctuations affecting the overall economy and may or may not be approved at the discretion of the Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative member.
15. Vendors are not required to bid on all districts to be considered for award.
16. **CN labeling or product nutritional specification sheets to be provided with bids.**
17. Cafeteria delivery locations, contact personnel, phone numbers, and other specific information will be provided to awarded vendors upon award unless requested prior to bid submissions.
18. Each Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative member reserves the option to add locations and quantities during the contract period.
19. Due to current budget cuts at the local, state, and federal levels, the benefits of fixed pricing guarantees over variable pricing will be reviewed and scrutinized along with other factors by the committee of Food Service Directors evaluating this proposal.

All , “qualified” proposals will be considered in the best interest of the ESC Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative members currently participating in this contract as well as future members who may wish to participate and utilize this contract during the performance period.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS- READ CAREFULLY

1. All milk shall be US Grade A, fresh, approved, pasteurized, homogenized and fortified with 400 IU of vitamin D per quart within the limits of good manufacturing practices as per Federal requirements, Title 21 for standards of identity 2000 IU of vitamin A.
2. The milk fat percentages specified shall be in accordance with the Texas Department of Health Milk information Releases 78-2A from the Division of Milk and Dairy Products.
3. All cartons shall be marked with the date of expiration. Milk shall have a minimum of five (5) days shelf life remaining from the date of delivery.
4. Sufficient inventories to cover the needs of the district are to be carried by the supplier.
5. Unopened products are to be collected and credit by the vendor before or after any school holiday period if they no longer have an acceptable code expiration date. All unopened product must be collected and credited prior to all vacation periods. Credit for such milk shall be designated on a separate credit memo.
6. If Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative member must serve lunches or breakfasts without milk through fault of the awarded vendor, vendor agrees it must provide the reimbursement for those meals at the current regulatory authorized reimbursement rate.
7. Coding information must be furnished by the vendor with its proposal with written procedures for placing and changing orders. Replacement of bad products and hot shot orders will be required along with a case cost and extension.
8. Vendor must keep Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative members informed on the results of tests on half-pint milk products made by the Texas Department of Health or the USDA.
