Award of this contract will enable Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative members to purchase recycling services for those procurements that must comply with the new federal EDGAR requirement when federal funds are being utilized during the contract term. Benefits in award of this contract will reduce landfill waste, reduce waste control service costs, and eliminate harvesting of natural resources. Profit margins were negotiated, as there was only one response.

Special Conditions

1. **This solicitation is not a guarantee for a specific quantity or specific location. By earning a contract, vendors will be able to provide future services to any ASC members.**
2. This solicitation will be in compliance with all federal, state and local laws, codes and regulations regarding governmental entity recycling.
3. ASC members reserve the option to add and delete services as needed during the contract as well as set up frequency and times of pickup.
4. All waste containers will be steam cleaned, repaired, and maintained during the contract period by the awarded contractor routinely or when notified by member.
5. All dumpsters will have slant tops with plastic lids unless otherwise specified in response.
6. Awarded contractors will only pickup during times specified by the local government entity.
7. Awarded contractors agree during long holidays, summer breaks, and closures by the governmental entities, that recycle schedules will be stopped and those entities will not be charged by the contractor for pickups.
8. During the contract term, the awarded contractor(s) agree to provide these services to other local, state, and federal governments entities that become a member of the Allied States Cooperative unless locations are restricted in vendor bid response.
9. The program being submitted by potential awardees must mirror the curbside recycling program (cardboard, paper, mixed paper, junk mail, magazines, newspapers, #1,#2, and #3 plastics, metal, aluminum, at a minimum combined in one container)
10. The awarded contractor(s) must agree to work with each participating entity it is servicing by providing a quarterly report which includes audit information, recommendations, and an annual report will be submitted to each government entity detailing amount of recyclable materials collected from each government.
11. During the contract period, the contractor will notify each entity in writing if more than 10% of total recyclables picked up are being disposed of through any means (incineration, landfills, or otherwise) other than recycling. Each participating cooperative member will have the option to inspect any materials being rejected for recycling.
12. Awarded vendors agree to have a contact person available to each participating entity to work with each agency to optimize the daily operational features of the program to include but not be limited to best practices, lessening of contamination, and any other problem solving issues.
13. Tonnage reports should be provided monthly to ASC for distributing to members.
14. Members retain the right to determine the location of each container.
15. If a recycle bin is contaminated with non-recyclable materials, it will be the responsibility of the member to pay for the cleanup. Vendors will be asked to submit a price for cleanup of each recycle bin knowing in advance that it will be removed, replaced, and cleaned off premises ASC members will have the option to perform the cleaning internally. Vendors will provide this cost on their proposal submissions.
16. 6" lettering will be placed in one location at the front of each bin identifying the bin with "Recyclables Materials Only- No Trash".
17. The vendors will reserve the option to remove a pickup site who repeatedly violates the placement policy outlined in this proposal with items that contaminate approved materials, or places items that cannot be recycled in the recycle containers. These problems must be brought to the attention of the lead person for each recycling cooperative member prior to removal.

*Special Conditions- Some dumpsters may have flat tops, this provision does not apply to roll off dumpsters (20yd, 30yd, 40yd). All service locations must be within existing routed service areas. Contaminated containers subject to

additional \$29 per pickup sorting/handling fee (this will be billed automatically at the time of service with photos of contamination). Heavily contaminated containers, requiring swap out and cleaning, will be billed at \$145 per swap. Contaminated roll off dumpsters subject to sorting/handling fee of \$89 per ton. All roll off dumpsters (20yd, 30yd, and 40yd) are subject to a rental fee of \$125 per month.
