Aldaz) submitted a proposal, however, were not considered; vendors are delinquent on reporting and/or administrative fee payments. Debbie Bergen Promotional Products, Fundraiser Blankets (Birdy Boutique LLC), Positive Promotions, Inc., and Sherry's Sportswear & Specialty Advertising submitted a proposal, however, were not considered; vendors do not meet the scope of work. 1. This solicitation is not for product only. Must provide a service.
2. This solicitation and resulting contract(s) are for the purchase of Printing Services, Promotional Supplies, and Related. Supplies for this solicitation may include but are not limited to plaques, trophies, certificates, medals, ribbons, clocks, drinkware, carrying items, duffel bags, clothing, caps, office supplies, mousepads, pens, pencils, miscellaneous promotional gimmicks/holiday items, table tents, covers, signage, banners,

rubber stamps, decals, nameplates, and gaming tables. Printing services include but are not limited to bindery work, booklet making, collating, cutting, dye cutting, folding, hole punching, stapling, multi-color printing, offset printer color process printing, offset printer PMS color printing, one color printing, padding, color copying, black & white copying, continuous form printing, envelope printing, duplicating, NCR forms, laminating, thermography, typesetting, and framing.

3. Vendors, if a website is provided as your company's pricelist/catalog, only items/services that fall within the scope of work may be sold/provided under this contract. Any other items/services found in your website that do not fall within the scope of work, may not be sold/provided under this contract.
4. Members, if an awarded vendor provides their website as their catalog/pricelist, only items/services that fall within the scope of work may be procured under this contract. Any other items/services found in an awarded vendor's website that do not fall within the scope of work, may not be procured and will not be covered under this contract.
5. No artwork will be processed without first obtaining from the Program Director requesting the work, a sign-off sheet of the proposed work to be performed.
6. It is preferred that vendors have a storefront location for walk in business, however it is not required. However, it is required that vendors have a storefront location where services are to be performed. Services performed at home-based locations will not be considered for this solicitation.
7. Originals for "all jobs" awarded and processed will be the property of the cooperative members and must be returned upon completion.
8. Proofing by cooperative members will be required prior to processing awarded orders.
9. During the contract period, vendors may be requested to perform jobs with or without paper provided.
10. During the contract period, vendors may be requested to provide pickup and delivery or no pickup and delivery.
