Award of this contract will enable ESC Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative members and ESC Region 19 to purchase energy, environmental, and cost saving devices and services that can save users time, energy, money, and maintenance costs over conventional means. A proposal from Gage Electric Company was not complete in the response and was not considered. All vendors considered for award received a 9 or better out of a possible 10 for previous work performed from comparable accounts to the ESC Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative membership. A proposal by the Economizer Group Incorporated did not provide enough independent testing facility information, and therefore was not considered for award. Additionally, while the company claims electrical cost savings and holds a US Patent, adequate insurances could not be provided. Another proposal from B & M Machinery was turned in late, and was not considered. Another proposal from Building Automation and Service did not respond to item 2 of the proposal and it was also not considered.
